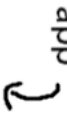
because those cowards at the

anything else.

the expire time is on the
paper slip you got when you
paid cash, shown on the
app, or visible on the screen
when you scan your card.

*northstar costs more.

wear shoes you could
walk a mile in
check the weather
dress like you might
be standing outside
for up to 30 minutes.
charge your phone
hat, scarf, & gloves,
october thru april.
sunscreen apr-oct
